Please feel free to call, write a note, or e-mail us if you have concerns or questions about your child's education.

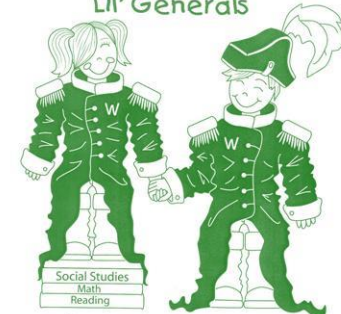
## Newsletter:
