### Take Home Folders:

### Planner

Please read and sign your child's planner nightly. If you need to send a note, this is a good place to put it also.

### Newsletter

We want to make sure you are informed of upcoming events and what your child is learning in school. A weekly newsletter will come home each week. It will contain schedules and information.

### Snacks

We will have a working snack time this year. Please send a healthy snack with your child each day and be aware of children in the room with allergies. Students may also bring a water bottle to be kept in their locker other than at snack time.

### Transportation Change

Please send a note if you need to change the way your child gets home. If a change needs to be made during the day, please call the office and speak to the secretary.

### Suggested School Supplies Please send ONLY these items (please note that all other items will be sent home due to space limitations):
