## Take Home Planners

Homework assignments, behavior notes, reminder of events, and Music/PE schedule will be written in your child's planner. ***Please check these planners nightly, sign and return them each day.*** All important papers and finished work will be sent home in this planner as needed.

## STAR

STAR Reading and Math assessments will be used at WES. These on-line assessments measure student growth, predict mastery on state assessments, and suggest skills and groupings for intervention.
